

Dear MEDA Program Students,

If you are planning to take MEDA 174L, Clinical Externship in the Spring 2022 semester, please note the following information:

- Registration for this course is temporarily blocked until requirements are verified. You will be allowed to add the course after completion of course prerequisites and completion of all required health clearance information/forms.
- You will be cleared for registration, using your priority registration date, if you have completed all course requirements by the stated deadline of **02/04/2022**. If these requirements are not completed by that date, you will lose your priority status and will not be cleared to register until all requirements are met and/or until the course is filled.

Prerequisites for Externship Course

• **MEDA 174L-A: Administrative Option (A):**

- *Prerequisites:* MEDA 160, 161, 162, 164, 164L, 165 or 166.

• **MEDA 174L-B: Clinical Option (B):**

- *Prerequisites:* MEDA 160, 164, 164L, 165 or 166, 170, 170L, 172;
- *Prerequisites or concurrently enrolled:* MEDA 171, 171L, 173.

• **MEDA 174L-C: Administrative and Clinical Option (C):**

- *Prerequisites:* MEDA 160, 161, 162, 164, 164L, 165 or 166, 170, 170L, 172
- *Prerequisites or concurrently enrolled:* MEDA 171, 171L and 173.

Clearance for registrations includes all of the following to be uploaded to American Databank Complio

- Copy of a current CPR/AHA BLS card at the level of a Professional Rescuer or Healthcare Provider*
- Copy of a current First Aid card
- Health Clearance (physical) and Immunizations are submitted through American DataBank.
