Transcripts from colleges and universities from outside the U.S. must be evaluated by an approved foreign service evaluator such as World Education Service. *Courses in progress are not accepted. 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CRITERIA 3

Prerequisites-Relevant Coursework GPA (maximum 30 points)

Minimum GPA for admission to the RN program is 2.0

GPA average in the following College of Marin courses or their equivalent courses:

1. Human Anatomy [BIO 120]
2. Human Physiology [BIO 224]
3. Microbiology [BIO 240]
4. Chemistry for Allied Health [CHEM 110] OR Introduction to Chemistry [CHEM 114] OR Survey of Organic and Biochemistry [CHEM 115]
5. Reading and Composition [ENG 150] **Admissions Requirement:** Credit for GPA will be based on evaluation of official transcripts. Submit your official transcripts from regionally accredited U.S. colleges and universities with the Petition for Substitution form, to Enrollment Services. College of Marin RN Program does not have a recency requirement for the prerequisite courses. Transcripts from colleges and universities from outside the U.S. must be evaluated by an approved foreign service evaluator such as World Education Service. *Courses in progress are not accepted. Please contact the Counseling Department for questions regarding courses.

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CRITERIA 4

Life experience or special circumstances (maximum 6 points) Select up to 3 life experience or special circumstances

24. 4a. Disabilities (2 point)

Required for points: Copy of Student Accessibility Services (SAS) evaluation or letter from physician documenting disability. The same meaning as use in Section 2626 of the Unemployment Insurance Code.

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25. 4b. Low Income (2 point)

Required for points: Documented eligibility for Cal-WORKS, EOPS, BOG fee waiver, Cal Grant, Pell Grant or other federal or state, needs based grant.

Files must be less than 10 MB and .pdf or web images format.

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26. 4c. Need to work (2 point)

Required for points: Upload paycheck stub during period of time enrolled in prerequisite courses OR letter from employer company letterhead stationary verifying employment at least part time while completing prerequisites.
*Example: if you completed BIO 120 in fall 2016 then your letter must reflect you worked during fall 2016 to receive this point allocation. This applies to all prerequisites completed.

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27. 4d. Disadvantaged social or educational environment (2 point)

Required for points: Participation in or eligibility for Extended Opportunity Program and Services (EOPS).

Files must be less than 10 MB and .pdf or web images format.

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28. 4e. Refugee status (2 point)

Required for points: Upload official document from United States Citizens Immigration Service (USCIS) indicating refugee status has been approved/granted (I-94 card with Refugee Admission Stamps or I-797 Notice of Action) with refugee status approved/granted.

Files must be less than 10MB and .pdf or web images format.

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29. 4f. Difficult personal or family circumstances (2 point)

Required for points: Upload written statement from applicant documenting difficult personal or family circumstances with any supporting documentation.

Files must be less than 10MB and .pdf or web images format.

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30. 4g. First generation to attend college (2 point)

Required for points: Upload written statement from applicant.

Files must be less than 10 MB and .pdf or web images format.

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31. **4h. Veteran status** (2 point)

Required for points: Upload copy of Defense Form DD-214 Honorable Discharge.

Files must be less than 10MB and .pdf or web images format.

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CRITERIA 5

Proficiency or Advanced Language, other than English (maximum 4 points)

Credit for languages other than English shall be received for languages that are identified by the Chancellor's Office. These may include but are not limited to the following: American sign language, Arabic, Chinese including its various dialects, Farsi, Russian, Spanish, Tagalog, the various languages of the Indian subcontinent and Southeast Asia.

32. Required for points: Upload ONE of the following:

- official transcript (ok to open and upload) from a US regionally accredited college or university verifying 4 separate and progressive level courses of the same foreign language with a grade of C or better for each semester within the last 5 years.
 - OR Letter from clergy, professor, or supervisor, if it is a native language (must be able to speak, read and write in language).
- Files must be less than 10 MB and .pdf or web images format.

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CRITERIA 6

Assessment/Readiness-ATI TEAS (maximum 40 points)

(ATI TEAS-current version 7 released June 2022). We will accept TEAS version 7 this year.

Minimum adjusted individual score required for application is 62%. Only ONE attempt allowed within 365 days (first attempt will be counted). Thank you for applying to the College of Marin Registered Nursing program. We have received your application and will review it at the conclusion of the application cycle in February.
